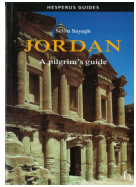

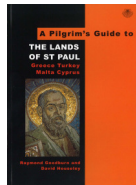


The Jordan pilgrim's guide is a new publication specifically covering the Christian sites we will be visiting and is the ideal travel companion.

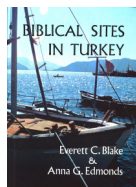
THE JOURNEYS OF ST PAUL THROUGH GREECE AND TURKEY

by Raymond Goodburn & David Houseley



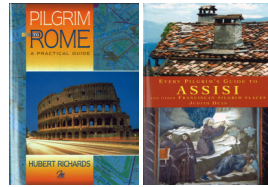

ITALY



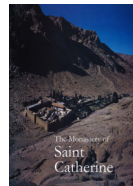
We have selected two guides written specifically for pilgrim parties visiting Rome and Assisi. If you are buying one book, we recommend Richards. Judith Dean's book is smaller

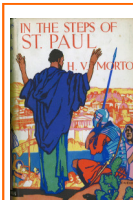

There are various guides on the market but sometimes they are hard to locate. This is our current favourite.

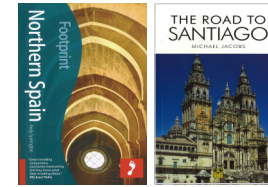
Footprint Syria & Lebanon £12.99

THE PILGRIMAGE TO SANTIAGO



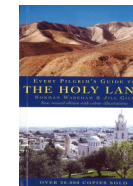

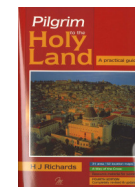
THE HOLY LAND

by Norman Wareham and Jill Gill



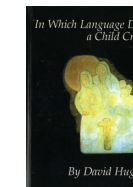
Norman and Jill have led many pilgrimages to the Holy Land with McCabe and this pocket-size companion covers all the principal sites and includes Bible references.
