THE CHALLENGE

The Revd Andrew McCabe MBE has been associated with the James Harvey Memorial School for more than 50 years. The school caters for over 1,000 day pupils, both boys and girls, and is funded by the Indian government who are happy with the school's Christian based teaching. Andrew's special interest is the **Anand Niwas Boys Home** attached to the school where 200 boys aged 5-18 are nurtured and given the opportunity of an education. Our challenge is to provide the finance for this home to have a secure future.

The monthly budget of the home is £6,000 and it is our ambition to raise half of this amount in a regular and sustainable way. Nawabganj is in a remote, rarely visited corner of India and the home relies on support from us and others like us.
